

Alice: Yes, it is. Stranger: Great.

Alice: I'm going there too.

Stranger: Really? What are you going to do on Main Street?

Alice: I'm going to do some shopping.

Stranger: And what are you going to buy?

Alice: I'm going to buy some clothes. And what about you?

Stranger: I'm going to meet some friends. We are going to watch a movie together.

Alice: Sounds good. Oh here's our train.

Stranger: Great.

Dialogue 3 - At the bus stop

Stranger: Hi, have you been waiting long?

Alice: About 10 minutes. It's going to arrive soon. I hope.

Stranger: Where are you going? **Alice:** I'm going to University Street.

Stranger: Are you a student?

Alice: No. I'm just going to meet a friend for coffee. What about you?

Stranger: I'm going to visit the museum. Have you been there? **Alice:** Yes, a few times. It's very interesting. Is it your first time?

Stranger: Yes, it is.

Alice: I'm sure you're going to enjoy it.
