

Instructor note: To practise giving instructions, the following cue cards can be cut and distributed to learners, who will give instructions for the task on the card. Ideally, the cue card tasks should be elicited from learners and relevant to their lives.



make a sandwich

set the safety alarm

find a postal code on the internet

set a table for two

take a picture with a phone

make a salad

make a photocopy



clean up after a meal

do laundry

send a text message

clean up after a class

hang a picture on the wall

make coffee

make a bed

Instructor note: The sample mall floor plan below can be used for a pair or group activity, where learners give directions to places of their choice. Alternately, make a list of places with suite numbers (e.g. 103 - post office, 105 shoe store, 107 - kids' clothing), then have learners quiz each other on giving or following directions.
