Children Under 6 Years

Children under the age of six are admitted FREE of charge when accompanied by a parent or guardian. For child safety in and around the water, the City requires that all participants comply with the following policy: *"For every two children under the age of six, there must be one adult or responsible youth (16 years or older) within arm's length, supervising the children's water play and activity."* The best life preserver for your child is YOU! Infants and toddlers participating in water play must wear an appropriate swim diaper.
