### GARAGE SALES

Saturday and Sunday morning (1) is the time for many garage sales. Garage sales are also often called yard sales. People sell things they do not want or need (2) anymore. The price is usually less than half the price at the store (3).

People like shopping (4) at garage sales because they can save money (5) and find interesting things. It also makes less garbage if people can reuse things.

You can find many different things at a garage sale. Some people sell furniture (6), like chairs or tables. Others sell baby clothes (7) or toys. You can also find things like lamps or bicycles.

If you want a cheaper price at a garage sale, you can try to bargain. Ask if you can get a cheaper (8) price if you buy two things, not just one.

### FLEA MARKETS

Flea markets are like big garage sales, with many tables (9) and many sellers. People donate things to the church so it can make money. Flea markets are good places (10) to find music, tools, jewelry and clothes.

### THRIFT STORES

Thrift stores are second-hand stores. Sometimes thrift stores make money for charity. Thrift stores are good places to buy (11) clothes or sports equipment.

If you have something you do not want or use anymore, don't throw it in the garbage (12), sell it or donate it to charity!
