

## SIMPLE PRESENT AND PROGRESSIVE , SIMPLE PAST OR SIMPLE FUTURE!

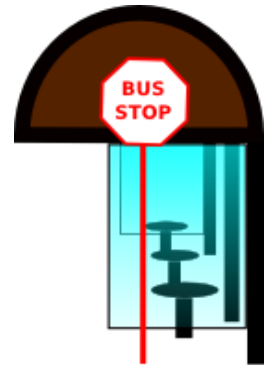
